SANCTION ORDER

Subject: Release of Assignment Sanction of Rs. 2,11,00,000/- (Rupees Two Crore Eleven Lakh Only) as 1st Installment to National Productivity Council (NPC) through Central Tool Room (CTR) Ludhiana (CNA) under TSA Model-1A/Hybrid Mode for conducting various Industry Awareness and Training Programs by NPC during FY 2025-26, under MSME Competitive (Lean) Scheme - reg.

The undersigned is directed to convey the sanction of the President of India for issuance of assignment sanction of Rs. 2,11,00,000/- (Rupees Two Crore Eleven Lakh Only) as 1st Installment to Central Tool Room (CTR) Ludhiana (CNA) under TSA Model-1A/Hybrid Mode towards making payment to National Productivity Council (NPC) for various Awareness and Training Program, as assigned in the Annual plan FY 2025-26, approved in 8th meeting of PMAC held on 08.04.2025 for MSME Competitive (Lean) Scheme (MCLS). The assignment sanction is issued to CNA Account of Central Tool Room (CTR) Ludhiana as Central Nodal Agency (CNA) for further providing assignment limit/drawing limit to Subsidiary Account (SA) of NPC for MSME Competitive (Lean) Scheme. This amount shall be utilized by NPC against drawing limit assigned by CNA in PFMS.

2. The Grant-in-Aid will be regulated in accordance with the OM of Dept. of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance vide No. 3(06)/PFMS/2023 dated 21st May, 2024 regarding Master Circular - Procedure for release of funds under the Central Sector Schemes (CSS) and monitoring utilization of the funds released as per TSA Model-1A/Hybrid Mode and provisions contained in the MSME Competitive (LEAN) Scheme guidelines. CTR, Ludhiana has been nominated as CNA vide letter dated 13.09.2022 issued by RAMP division of this Ministry and NPC is the Implementing Agency of MSME Competitive (LEAN) Scheme. CTR, Ludhiana shall strictly follow the roles and responsibilities mentioned in the aforesaid O.M. and further circulars/orders of DoE issued from time to time. The assignment sanction issued, is also subject to the provisions contained in Chapter-9 of the General Financial Rules, 2017, as amended from time to time, read with the Government of India's decisions incorporated there-under and any other guidelines which may be issued in this regard and in particular to the following conditions:

- CTR, Ludhiana and NPC shall maintain separate account of Grant-in-Aid received from the Government and utilized as per TSA Model – 1A of DoE.
- The grant shall be utilized strictly as per the scheme guidelines for Implementation of MSME Competitive (Lean) Scheme under MSME Champions Scheme in Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises (MSME)/GoEs and as per MoU signed by NPC with this department,**

- iii) National Productivity Council, New Delhi as SA may furnish their performance-cum-achievement report regularly.
- iv) NPC should maintain a register of permanent and semi-permanent assets acquired wholly or mainly out of the above grant in the prescribed format and copy thereof should be furnished to this Ministry.
- v) If any capital assets are created out of this sanction, the O/o the DC (MSME) will be the sole proprietor of the same. Assets acquired wholly or substantially out of Government Grant shall not be disposed of without obtaining the prior approval of the sanctioning authority of Grant-in-aid.
- vi) The accounts of CTR, Ludhiana and NPC shall be open for inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit, both by the Comptroller & Auditor General of India under the provision of C&AG(DPC) Act, 1971 in accordance with the provisions laid down in Section-14 of the C&AG (DPC 1971) as amended from time to time and Internal Audit Party of the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry of Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises (MSME), whenever it is called upon to do so.
- vii) The grantee shall submit the Utilization Certificate in the prescribed form GFR-12 duly signed by the Head of the Institution/ Grantee latest by 31.03.2026. The utilization certificate in respect of grants should also disclose whether the specified, quantified and qualitative targets that should have been reached against the amount utilized were in fact reached, and if not, the reasons there for. They should contain an output-based performance assessment instead of input-based performance assessment.
- viii) National Productivity Council (NPC), New Delhi shall furnish an Audited Statement of Accounts of the financial year before 30.04.2025 also indicating separately Activity-wise and Head-wise expenditure.
- ix) Grant-in-Aid shall be utilized subject to the Economy and other Instructions issued from time to time by the M/o Finance or by the Competent Authority
- x) National Productivity Council, New Delhi shall certify that the utilization certificates due for submission for the Grants-in-aid sanctioned in the previous year containing all the relevant details under GFR 212(1) have been submitted to the satisfaction of the Minister (Ministry of MSME).
- xi) NPC shall certify that no grants for this purpose or activities have been applied for or obtained from any other Ministry or Department of the Government of India or State Government.
- xii) CTR, Ludhiana and NPC shall adhere to all the relevant provisions of GFR and any other instructions/guidelines issued by the Government from time to time, while making procurement/purchases of goods and services including compliance to GFR provisions in case of out-sourcing of services and engagement of consultant.
- xiii) NPC has been exempted from execution of the bond. NPC shall, however, furnish an undertaking that it will comply with all the terms and conditions stipulated in the sanction order.
- xiv) CTR, Ludhiana should send pre-receipted bill and undertaking to agree to the terms & conditions of this sanction (in Triplicate) to this Ministry for payment of the amount drawn against this sanction.
- xv) In no case the grant released under this sanction will be utilized for any purpose other than those indicated in the sanction. The grantee shall not divert the grants and entrust execution of the Scheme or work concerned to another Institution or Organization and shall abide by the terms & conditions of the grant and follow/adhere to all the relevant provisions of GFR regarding Grants-in-aid. If the grantee fails to utilize the grant for the purpose for which the same has been sanctioned or does not adhere to the terms & conditions of Grant and GFR provision, the grantee/Institution shall be required to refund the grant with interest @ 10% per annum, if any.
- xvi) NPC may encourage SC, ST, OBC, PH, women & minority categories of MSMEs in the scheme activities. Further, while incurring the expenditure austerity measures should be

- xvii) considered as issued from time to time by competent authority.
- xviii) NPC may use the fund as per prescribed guidelines of proposed MSME Competitive (LEAN) Scheme relating to the programs. The expenditure under the sanction is maximum, saving if any, will be surrendered to the Govt. Account.
- xix) The grantee institution shall not utilize the interest earned on the recurring/non-recurring grants-in-aids released for any purpose. The interest earned shall be deposited to Consolidated Fund of India (Bharat Kosh) as per the guidelines issued by Department of Expenditure, M/o Finance.
- xx) NPC will provide all technical inputs including preparation of background documents/course material identification of suitable topics and faculty for presentation. The financial support by GoI may cover wherever necessary, the expenses towards rent for venue, training materials, audio/video aids. TA/DA and honorarium to the Guest Faculty, expenditure on transport, purchase of stationary items, refreshment, and other miscellaneous expenses as per Govt. of India rules viz. F.R.46 (11-Honorarium to guest faculty), S.R. 190a (travelling allowance to persons who are not in civil service), Government assistance is only for organizational expenses of the proposed event and not for capital items like equipment etc. Further, the procedure prescribed under GFR including the various guidelines under the economy measures shall be followed.
- xxi) Noted at Serial No. 02 in the Register of Grants.
- xxii) DDO of Ministry of MSME will act as Drawing and Disbursing Officer for this Sanction.
3. The progress of the scheme would be monitored by the PMAC, O/o DC (MSME).
4.
