Sir,

I am directed to convey the Assignment Sanction of the President of Rs. 36,32,000/- (Rupees Thirty Six Lakh Thirty Two Thousand Only) under Raising and Accelerating MSMEs Performance (RAMP) Infrastructure Development and, Capacity Building "Grants-in-aid General" to Central Tool Room, Ludhiana (as CNA) under TSA Model-1A (Hybrid) during the Financial Year 2025-26.

2. PAO (MSME), New Delhi may assign the Sanction Amount of Rs. 36,32,000/- (Rupees Thirty Six Lakh Thirty Two Thousand Only) to Central Tool Room Ludhiana and further Central Tool Room, Ludhiana would be giving assignment/ drawing limits to NSIC and NSIC will be using this assignment / drawing limit for Conducting Skill Development Training Programme during the Financial Year 2025-26. 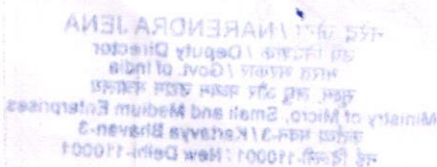
3. The proposal of National Small Industries Corporation Limited (NSIC), New Delhi for funding of Rs.181.60 Lakhs under RAMP to conduct Skill Development Training Programme was approved for conducting 76 programmes targeting 1520 trainees over the country (estimated as per ATI scheme guidelines). Details of releases and utilization for the purpose are as under:

The Grant-in-aid General will be regulated in accordance with the OM of Dept. of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance vide NO. 1 (18)/PFMS/FCD/2021 dated 9th March, 2022 (copy attached) regarding revised procedure for flow of funds under Central Sector Schemes and provisions contained in the RAMP Programme. CTR, Ludhiana has been nominated as CNA vide letter No. Nil dated 13.09.2022 for RAMP Scheme (copy enclosed). CTR, Ludhiana shall strictly follow the roles and responsibility as mentioned in the aforesaid O.M. The funds released are also subject to the provisions contained in Chapter 9 of the General Financial Rules, 2005, as amended from time to time, read with the Government of India's decisions incorporated there-under and any other guidelines which may be issued in this regard and in particular to the following conditions:-

- Grant-in-Aid General shall be utilized subject to the Economy and other Instructions issued from time to time by the M/o Finance or by the Competent Authority.
- CTR, Ludhiana shall adhere to all the relevant provisions of GFR 2017 and any other instructions/guidelines issued by the Government from time to time.
- In no case, the grant released under this sanction will be utilized for any purpose other than those listed in the proposal.

8. CTR Ludhiana as CNA may deduct the tax amount if applicable.

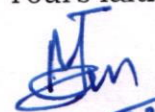
