I am directed to convey the sanction of the President for release the advance payment of Rs. 125.00 Cr. (Rupees One hundred and Twenty Five Crore only) under **"Professional Services" Head** towards making payment to **Central Tool Room, Ludhiana as Central Nodal Agency (CNA)** for Strategic Investment Plans (SIPs) preparation by the States and UTs under RAMP during the Financial Year 2022-23. 3. States/UTs can utilize this fund to meet all expenditures directly related to the preparation of the SIP. This would include expenditure for hiring of resources, necessary domestic travel (air/train/road), conducting consultations and meetings for SIP preparation, stationery and essential office expenditure etc. Unrelated expenditure like ACs, furniture, vehicles etc will not be funded through RAMP. The States would be free to choose the size of the SPIU/consultants they would hire for the SIP preparation. The States must strictly adhere to the timeline for submission of SIPs. They may plan the size of the SPIU/consultants team accordingly. Also, the States can enjoy the flexibility of planning their expenditure towards all the above expenses within the cap of Rs. 5 Cr, subject to conforming to financial rules laid out in GFR, 2017. The States/UT will be given time upto **28th Feb 2023** to submit the SIPs to this Ministry after due approvals at their end.

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4. The States/UTs must follow principles of accountability and procedures of financial discipline and administrative due diligence, as laid out in the GFR, 2017.

5. Central Tool Room, Ludhiana shall release the amount to the respective States/UTs after submission/upload all requisite documents on MIS portal. CTR, Ludhiana has been nominated as CNA vide letter dated 13.9.2022 for Raising and Accelerating MSMEs Performance (RAMP) Scheme (Copy of the order enclosed for reference). The Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure's O.M. F.1(18)/PFMS/FCD/2021 dated 9.3.2022 (Copy enclosed).

6. The receipt of this letter may kindly be acknowledged and action taken may be intimated to this Ministry. CTR Ludhiana will also submit the adjustment bill for Rs. 125/- cr. after release the entire amount to States/UTs.

7. SO/DDO of the office of the M/o MSME will act as Drawing and Disbursing Officer for this sanction.

8. Noted at Serial No. 01 in the Register of Grants.

9. The progress of the scheme would be monitored by the M/o MSME.

10. The expenditure involved will be met out from the budget provision (BE) for Raising and Accelerating MSMEs Performance (RAMP) States (EAP) and shall be debited in **demand No. 68** of Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises for the Financial year 2022-23 as follows:
